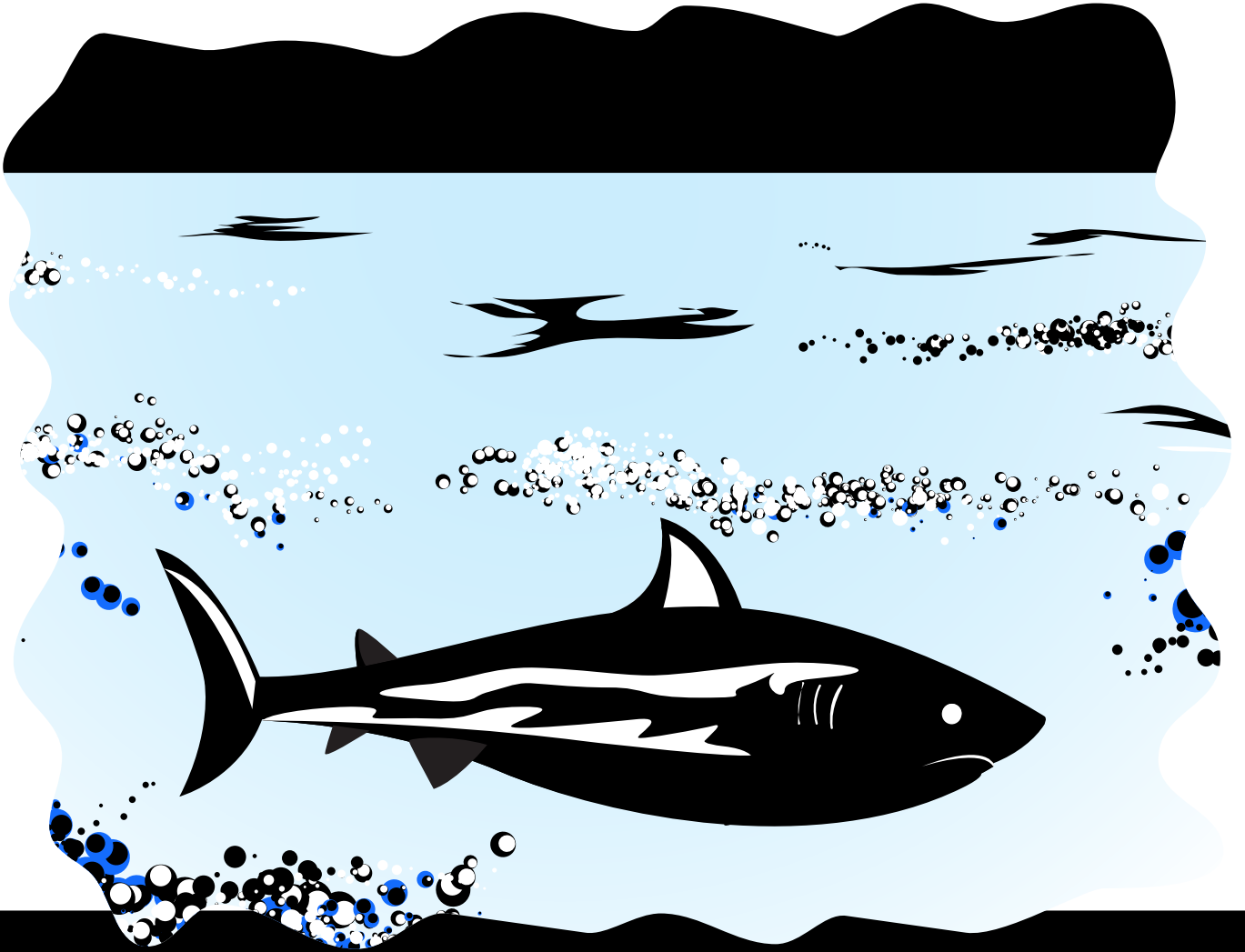

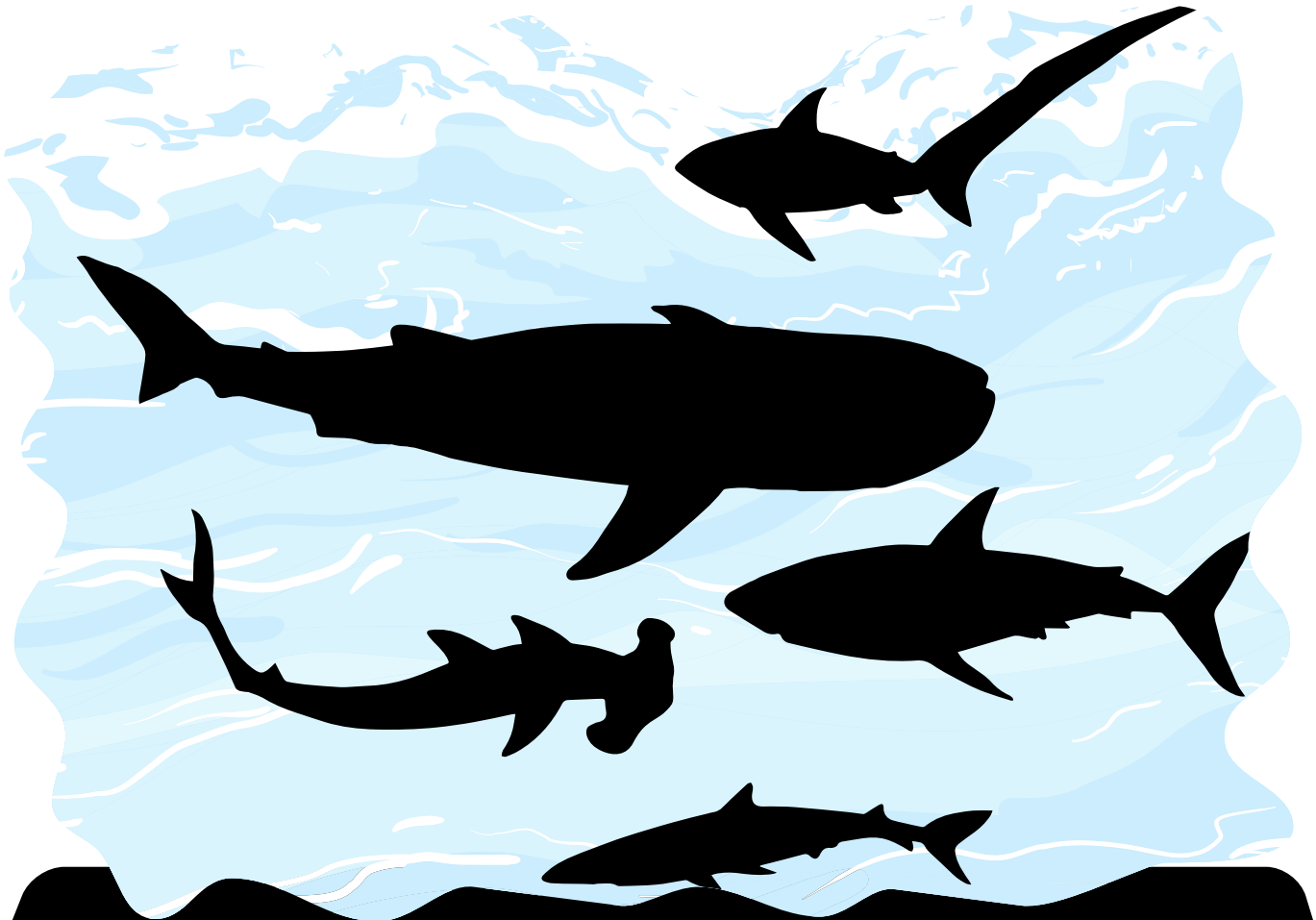
Meet the Sharks

dinosaurs!**

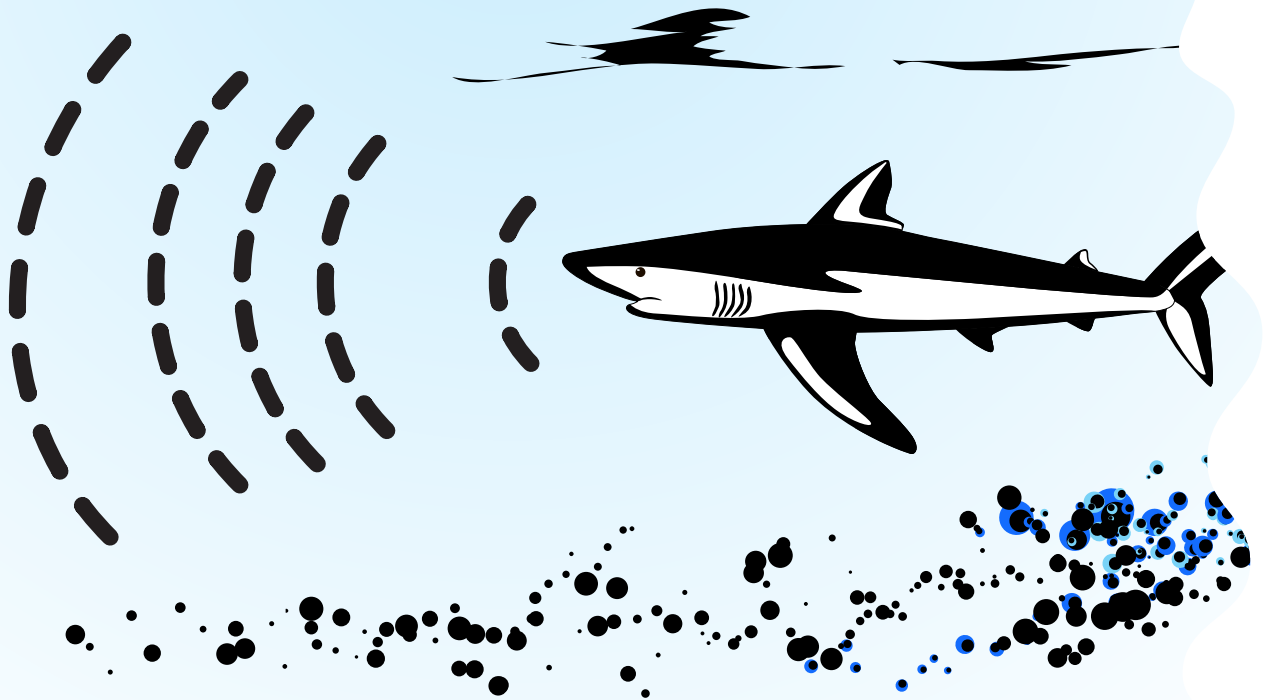


Different Species

Super Senses



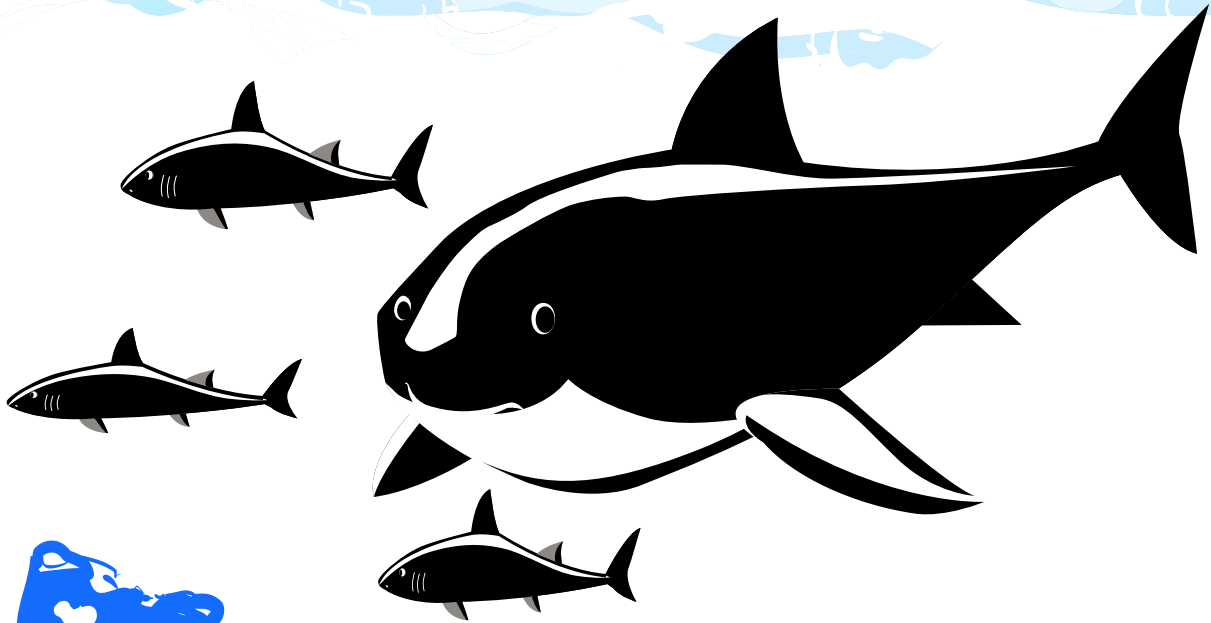
Sharks have excellent senses, including the ability to detect electrical fields from other animals.

Shark Teeth



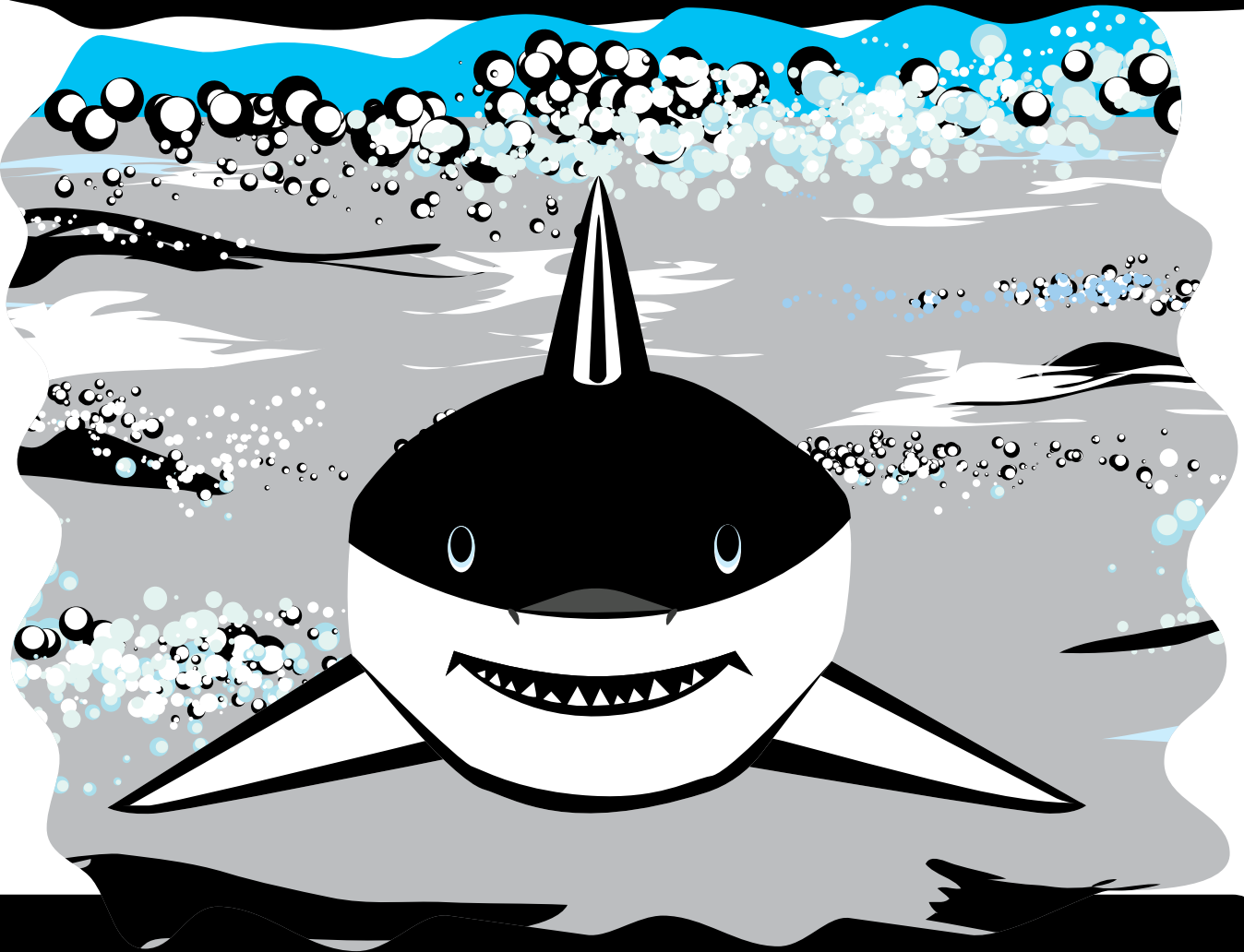
Sharks can have up to 3,000 teeth at one time and they continuously lose and replace them throughout their lives.

Shark Pups



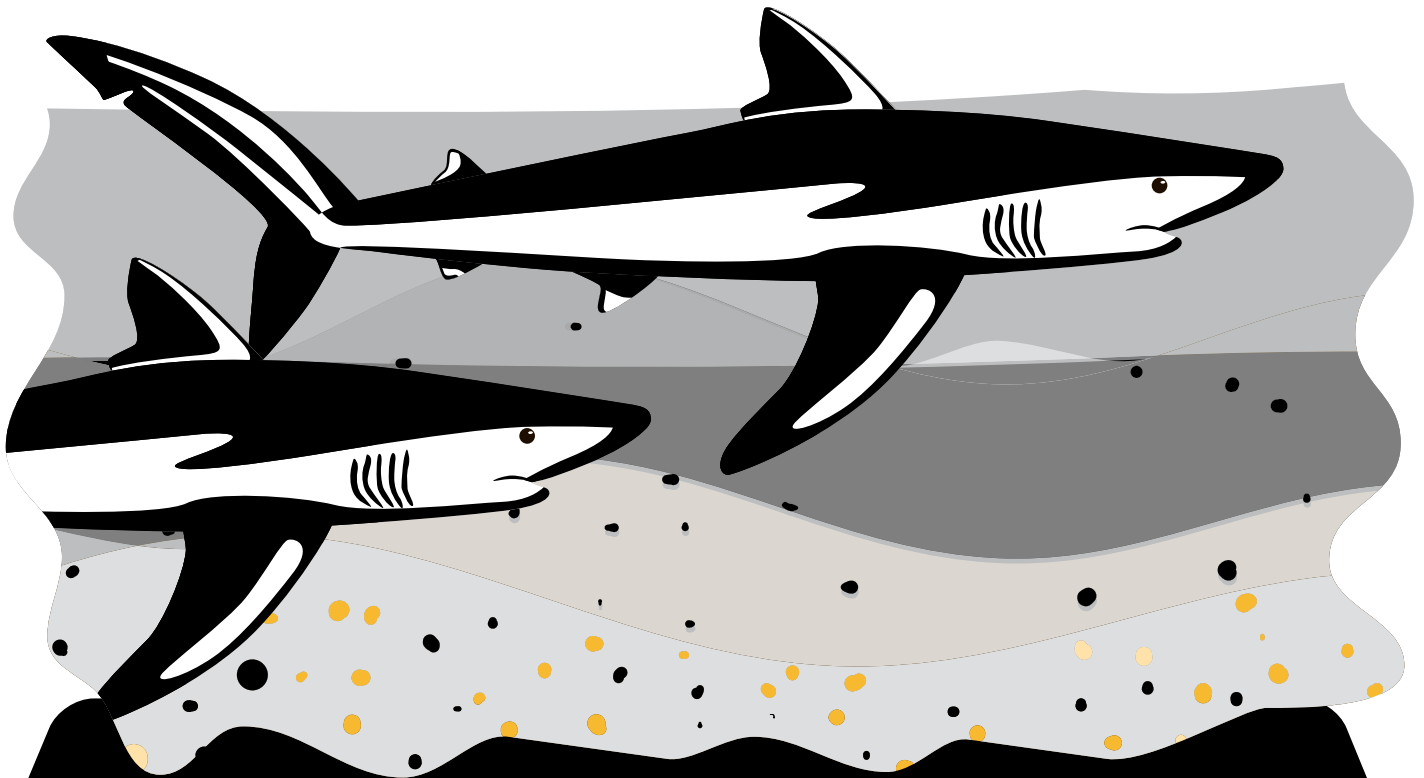
**Baby sharks are called pups.
